INTRODUCTION: The Southern Nevada Water Authority ("Owner") hereby invites interested persons or organizations, qualified as a construction manager/general contractor ("Applicants"), to submit written Proposals for the performance of construction manager at risk services for the **Low Lake Level Pumping Station** Project ("Project"). The design engineer is **MW/Hill** (joint venture between MWH Americas, Inc. and CH2M Hill, Inc).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Southern Nevada Water Authority is issuing this Request for Proposals (RFP) for a Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR) for pre-construction and construction services pertaining to the Lake Mead Intake No. 3 Low Lake Level Pumping Station. The Project includes the construction of a 20-foot-diameter, 525-foot-deep shaft, a large underground forebay, 33 well shafts, the procurement and installation of deep submersible pumps, a motor control center with building, and electrical and other utility service connections and appurtenances. These improvements are in direct response to the continued drought and will enable the Owner to continue to supply water to Southern Nevada at very low lake levels.

Estimated Construction Phase (Multiple Packages): September 2015 through April 2020

OPINION OF PROBABLE CONSTRUCTION COST (OPCC): \$440 Million USD (Class 5 Estimate)
